Many of our attractions have excellent restaurants on-site. The listings on the previous pages detail the seating capacity for their on-site restaurants and cafés. Venues that we have recommended in the itineraries (pages 6-7) include **The John Thompson Inn** at Ingleby, which is renowned for the quality and value of both its lunchtime carvery and home brewed ales. **Classics** is set in a beautiful medieval barn in the grounds of Donington le Heath Manor House, with its terrace overlooking the newly restored seventeenth century herb garden. **Appleby Inn** is located just off the A42, handy for Twycross and Conkers, and regularly caters for large groups, offering good value for money.
