What to look for

Enclosed by hedgerow, the site offers an area of open access. An open meadow with specimen trees (including a range of native species and fruit trees) is the main feature.

Planting of broadleaved species, with a high proportion of flowering trees and shrubs, make the link between the site and its past history as a garden, as well as enhancing its aesthetic appeal.

Extension of an existing flash has created a shallow pool and marsh with associated wetland species such as marsh marigold.
