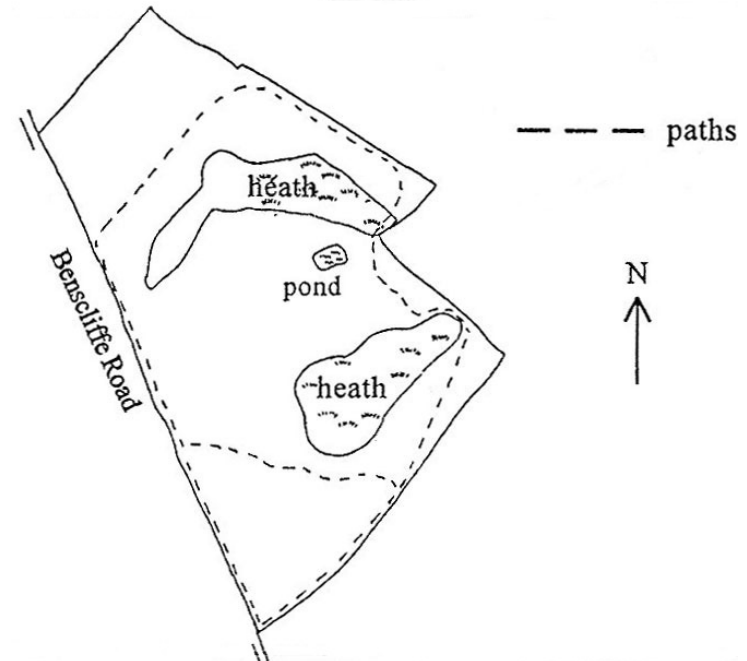
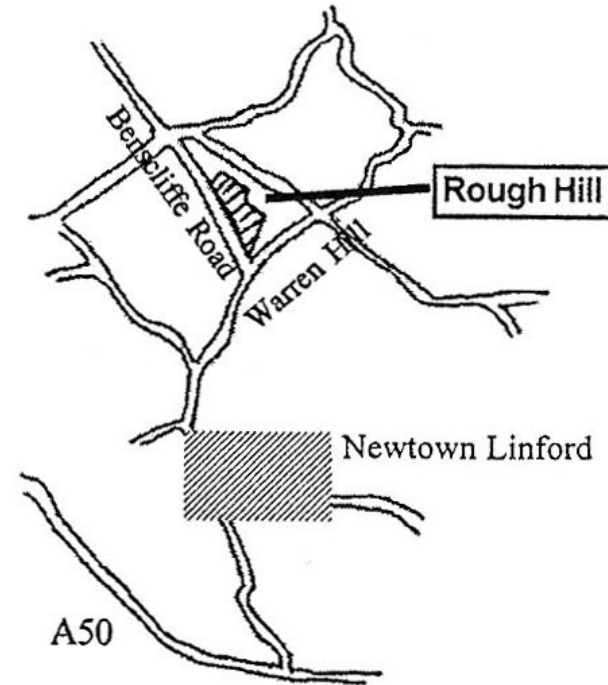
What to look for

This woodland comprises a good mixture of habitats. An existing spinney has been thinned to favour the broadleaved trees.

Bracken has been removed and heather seeding used to establish heath grassland and heathland typical of the area.

The rocky outcrops provide habitats for lichens and basking area for invertebrates and reptiles.

The pond is being managed for waterfowl and a floating island provides nesting and roosting area.
