

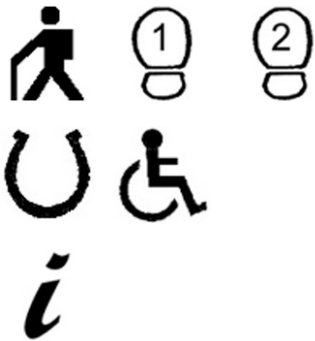

What to look for

Community involvement has been a major part of the creation of this site. Over two successive years members of the public planted trees as part of the National Forest “Grow a Tree From Seed” campaign in their own community woodland plot.

The meadow at the southern end is managed as a hay meadow under the advice of Derbyshire Wildlife Trust who manage the adjacent Carvers Rock SSSI.

The 3 dimensional wooden interpretation sign is a distinctive and unusual feature.
