## Nearby sites to visit

- Groby Pool is situated across the road. The site is privately owned but you are able to walk around most of the pool on a permissive path.
- Bradgate Park is nearby at Newton Linford and can be reached on foot.

## What to look for

The western part of the woodland contains a car park and picnic area, Most of this woodland block has been harvested with new broadleaf planting replacing conifers.

The eastern part of the woodland is a Site of special Scientific Interest (SSSI). It is one of the best examples of ash and alder woods in Leicestershire.

Access to the SSSI is via the marked nature trail only.
