What to look for

The wood comprises mixed broadleaved trees - mainly oak, ash and birch with rowan, cherry and alder. 200 Wildstar cherry - a faster growing and more disease resistant variety of wild cherry - are planted in one corner.

A pond in the centre of the site provides habitats for aquatic species.

Bat and bird boxes provide roosting and nesting sites.

Horse riding is available on a permit basis and a new bridleway link has been made to the adjoining Partings Wood.
