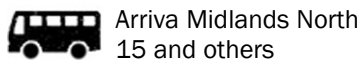

## What to look for

Planting has taken place over a three year period under the Tender Scheme to bring the Forest into the heart of the town.

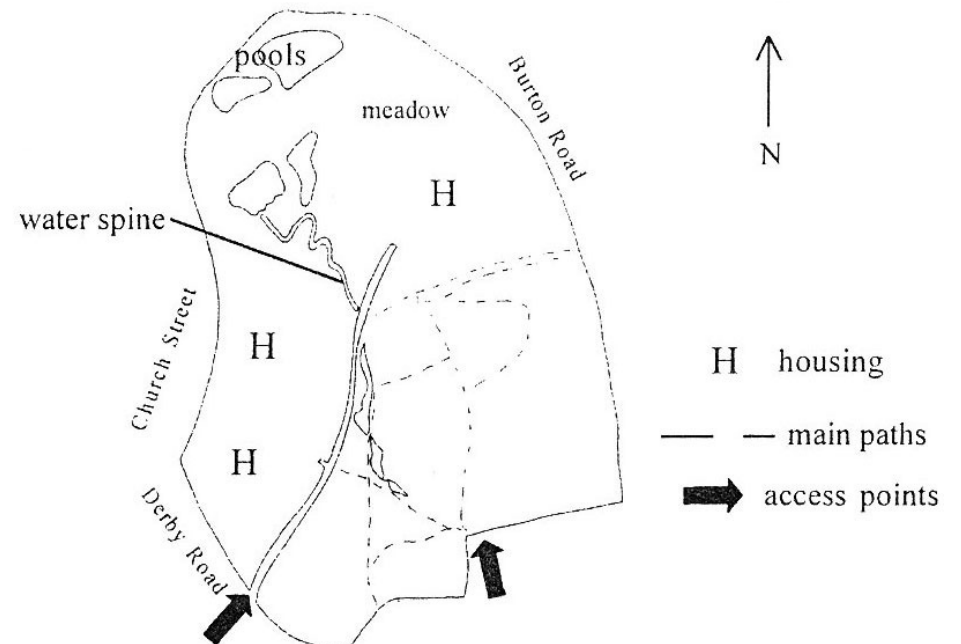
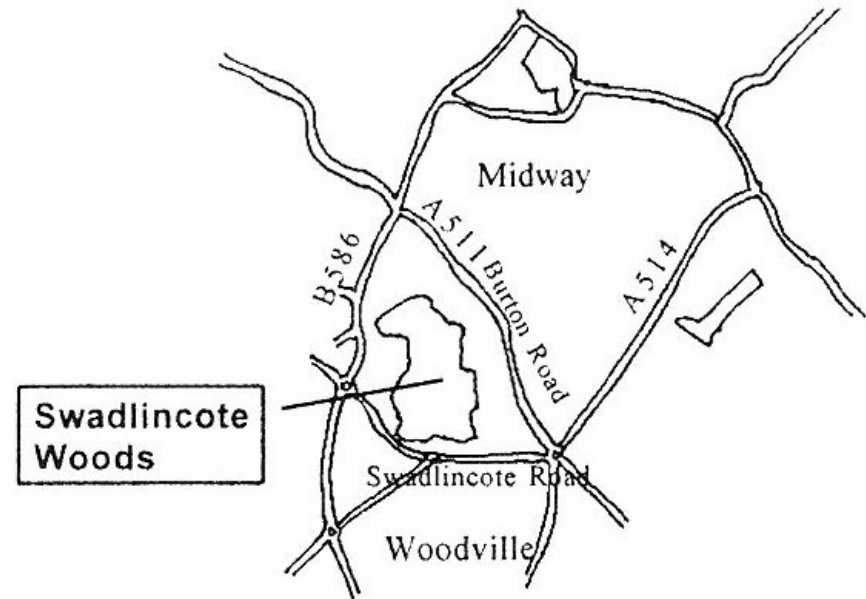
Surfaced paths give access for all abilities with arts and heritage features sponsored by local businesses planned along the paths.

A central water spine makes use of a natural spring to feed a series of shallow pools and weirs linked by foot-bridges.

An existing area of valuable grassland has been retained and managed as a meadow.

A central area shows different tree species planted in square blocks as an unusual feature.
